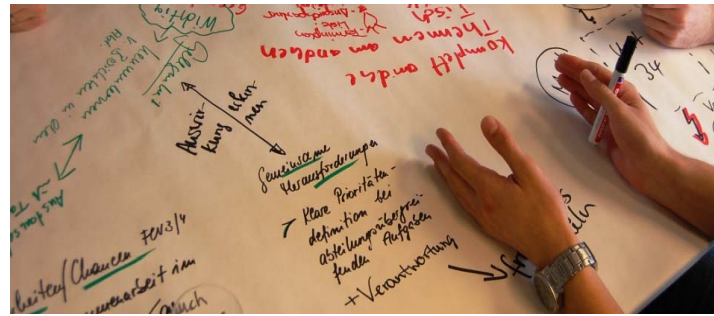


Moderation of large groups



World Café

Networking, exchange, mutual understanding, sharing of opinions

Participants with different levels of knowledge talk about a certain subject. Different opinions are brought together and understanding for different positions is created. Core subjects are brought up and first trends, ideas and responses are collected.

Process:

After a keynote speech or other impulse, the participants rearrange tables of four participants in always changing new combinations and discuss certain key questions.

While doing that three times, they visualize the most important results on the table cloth (paper). Afterwards, every table briefly presents the most important results ("Harvesting"). Finally, there will be a vernissage of all tableclothes.

The World Café gives a good start to workshops or congresses with large heterogeneous groups.
